BARN RULES

Our rules are in place to keep Little Raven a safe, clean and friendly environment for both the horses and humans. Horses are large and sometimes unpredictable animals and we strive to keep accidents to a minimum. Please read the below listed rules. Thank you for your help!

1. An ASTM approved helmet must be worn at all times while mounted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. Boots with a heel must be worn while riding – no flip -flops, sandals or tennis shoes.
3. Our hours are 8am to 8pm. We are closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years Day. Barn gates will be shut during our closed hours.
4. No boarder is allowed to jump without a Little Raven Ranch instructor.
5. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult, or under the supervision of a professional.
6. Please clean up after yourself in the grooming areas, wash racks, tack rooms and in front of your stall. Manure must be picked up immediately. There are trash containers, shovels, brooms and buckets available for your use to dispose of items.
7. You may keep one trunk in front of your stall and a minimum number of blankets on your stall blanket racks. Any additional items may be kept in your locker or stored off property. Outside boarders will have use of the storage shed by their pens to keep tack & equipment. LRR recommends labeling your property. We are not responsible for stolen items.
8. Blankets should be fitted to your horse, with all straps working. Weather/ Water proof sheets and blankets will be required if you would like your horse turned out in.
9. **NO SMOKING** in or around the barns.
10. **NO dogs** please. Professionals and LRR employees are granted the privilege of bringing one dog, providing that it is properly managed and does not prove a hazard to others.
11. Please respect the privacy of our barn manager and live-on employees. Stay off of the residential property.
12. Horses are to be turned out in their designated area only- as per management.
13. Please do not leave your horse unattended in any area – grooming stalls, arenas, or wash racks.
14. All riders must sign a liability release form- this goes for any visitors or family members who will be riding your horse.
15. Please turn off the lights in the indoor arena if you are the last person riding at night.
16. All visitors/family members accompanying a boarder must remain quiet and well-behaved while at the stable. No screaming or running in the barn areas.
17. We reserve the right to charge for damages your horse might cause to our facilities beyond normal wear and tear.
18. No riding in the barn aisles.
